Eligibility requirements are as follows:

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior with a full-time attendance record at a Southern California high school.
2. Applicants must have maintained a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 throughout high school.
3. C.A.P.O.A. scholarship application package must include all the following items to be considered valid:
  - a) Completed application
  - b) Autobiography (One-Page Maximum, 12-Font)
  - c) High School Transcript
  - d) School Recommendation Letter (i.e., Counselor/Principal/Teacher) or Letter of Recommendation from a CAPOA Member
4. Applicants must submit a completed **typed** C.A.P.O.A. scholarship application package and mail it to the above P.O. box address or scan and email to [capoeditor@yahoo.com](mailto:capoeditor@yahoo.com) . It must be **emailed** or **postmarked** no later than **June 10, 2026**. The scholarships will be awarded on **July 18, 2026**, at the Scholarship Awards Luncheon.
